
Executive Summary



2018 Commonwealth Games

Protiviti continued to support the Commonwealth Games Steering Committee up to the commencement of the Games in April 2018. In the lead-up to the Games, the risk assessment was updated to reflect the stage in the planning. Our observations of ASADA's conduct of the Games activities (from afar) suggests that risks were managed adequately and the agency was able to deliver against its obligations.

The Audit Committee and Executive are recommended to consider the potential for a post-implementation review of lessons learned for future major event anti-doping activities.
